



The Asylum and Exile Commission of the LGBTI Centre, Grenoble

What is the Commission ?

It's a place where people seeking asylum for reasons of LGBTI-phobia can find support and community conviviality. We provide support and help, in particular for the preparation for interviews at the OFPRA and the CNDA.

Who are we ?

We are a group of activists, we are not professionnels, but we participate in trainings with other associations and learn a lot through asylum seekers sharing their experiences.

We have absolutely no ties to the préfecture or any other institutions involved in the asylum process.

The members of the commission speak english, french, spanish and german.

We are LGBTI people ourselves, or in close relation with LGBTI people.

Who's it for ?

Anybody seeking asylum because their sexual orientation and/or gender identity puts them in danger in their home country.

How does it work ?

We first meet with those seeking asylum in a one-on-one interview. All information shared in those interviews remains confidential.

We also hold monthly opening times which are opportunities to exchange and share information, share one's story, and to create a warm environment and a sense of community support.

When ?

For french speakers : the **3rd monday** of each month from **5 to 7 pm**.

For english speakers : the **3rd thursday** of each month from **5 to 7 pm**.

For those who speak **any other language**, it's better **to contact us beforehand** so we can find a solution.

Where ?

At the LGBTI center in Grenoble, which is a place to find resources, support and a friendly environment for all Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Trans' and Intersex people. The center is used by several different associations. The website is <https://centrelgbti-grenoble.org/>
